The International Heliophysical Year is a program of international scientific collaboration planned to be held in the period from 2007-2009. Many Brazilian institutions have shown interest in participating in the IHY activities. All of them provided information about their instrumental facilities and contact person. A list of institutions and their information is shown in the Latin-American IHY webpage (<http://www.alage.org/IHYLA/ihyla.html>), hosted by the Latin American Association on Space Geophysics - ALAGE. IHY Brazilian activities are being conducted in close collaboration with Latin-American Institutions. Five Coordinated Investigation programs (CIPs) have been proposed by scientists from Brazilian institutions. Recently, in February 2008, there has been the Latin American IHY School in Sao Paulo (Brazil), with the participation of 80 students from Brazil, Argentina, Peru, Mexico and Cuba. In this work, a report on the Brazilian activities will be presented.
